It is believed to be the responsibility of the landowner to repair. Cllr Putt to speak with Miss Haddon to see if the ownership of the land has been transferred to the Woodland Trust.

2281. RAF Bench

Cllr Walpole and Mr Burton concreted the bench in position around the tree on the Green. It has received many favourable comments throughout the village, and has been used by numerous walkers and cyclists and other visitors to the village.

2282. Playground repairs

It was RESOLVED to order a replacement handrail for the Berkeley Street entrance.
Clerk to chase quotes for the replacement parts for the rocker and basketball hoop
The rubber matting/tiles to be replaced once equipment is available
Quotes to be received for the trees and hedge to be trimmed.

2283. Reading Rooms

The Reading rooms are now open and available for use with strict Social distancing measures.
The Council will remain holding meetings online. A replacement kitchen is to be installed over Christmas period, funded by a COVID 19 grant.

2284. Zoom subscription

Due to the current social distancing measures, the Council will continue to hold meetings online. The subscription will continue at a cost of £14.39 per month, and will be reviewed in November if social distancing measures allow for face to face meetings.

i. Recreation Ground Inspection

Dog poo has been noticed in the area, Councillors are to be vigilant if any dogs spotted in the area. Cllr Holmes to ensure No Dog signs are in place.
Hand sanitiser on each entrance to remain in place while stocks last.

Husbands Bosworth have reported 4 cases of catalytic converters. All residents to remain vigilant.

iii. Highways

The village has had whitelines refreshed, the Aerodrome Road drains cleared.
